Pre-Studies: Day 1

Completion of Heli-College Canada Training Inc required documentation.
Discussion with your Instructor, outlining the course and the expected progress schedule.

Day 1, 2 Studies

Canadian Air Regulations (CARs)

Study of CARs using books and study material provided by Heli-College Canada Training Inc. including in-house computer quizzes AIR Regulations 1, up to and including Air Regulations 13

Meteorology

Review meteorological phenomenon focusing on interpretation of aviation weather forecasts and particularly how it relates to instrument flight. Use books and study material provided by Heli-College Canada Training Inc. including in-house computer quizzes METROL 1, up to and including METROL 12

Day 3

Appointments will have been made for the pilot to go today to the Aviation Medical Doctor and ECG for required examinations.

Day 4

- Complete CAR's worksheet. Review of general CAR's information to be completed without the use of reference material.
- Complete CAR's Final Exam
- Ground briefing with Instructor to discuss any areas needing further explanation

Day 5/6

- Complete MET worksheet. Review of general MET information to be completed without the use of reference material.
- Study METAR/TAF/GFA Information material (Meteorological Aviation Reports, Terminal Forecasts and General Area Forecasts) and related quizzes
- Ground brief with Instructor
- Meteorology Final Exam
- Brief with Instructor to discuss any questions regarding results of Meteorology Final

Day 7/8

- Study reference material with relation to Aircraft Instruments.
- complete Aircraft Instruments quiz, Instrument Function Exam and Instrument quiz #2
- Brief with Instructor each day on results and progress

Day 9

- Study material and complete the Radio Exam
- Study and complete:
